



Comfort, Comfort Now My People



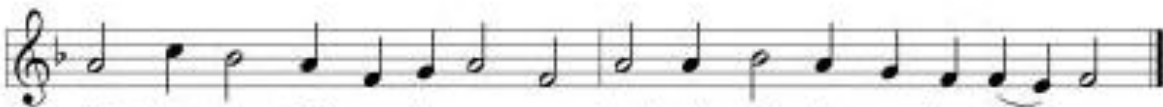
