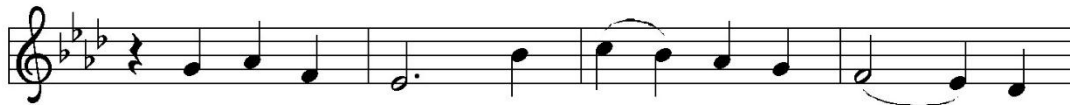



THANKSGIVING AT THE TABLE (ELW p. 108)

On that first Easter morning when the women discovered the empty tomb, they told the disciples what they'd found. When Peter heard the news, he ran to the garden, looking for a reason to hope.

Sometimes we are like Peter, running to this Table, hungry and longing for a taste of good news. And sometimes we are like the other disciples, hanging back, arms crossed, tentative and unsure.

No matter where we stand and what we feel, this Table is for all of us.

The one who walked this earth, healed the sick, welcomed the children, and loved the outcast, welcomes you to this Table.

In the night in which he was betrayed,
our Lord Jesus took bread and, giving thanks to you, said:
Take and eat; this is my body, given for you.
Do this for the remembrance of me.

In the same way he took the cup, gave thanks,
and gave it for all to drink, saying:

This cup is the new covenant in my blood,
shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin.
Do this for the remembrance of me.

God of yesterday, tomorrow, and right now, God of the sun, the moon, and the
pink before dawn, God of our head, our heart, and our gut, we ask you to meet us
here. Meet us in this sanctuary. Meet us in this community. Meet us at this Table.
Pour out your Spirit on this bread and cup. Roll back the stone, again and again, as
many times as it takes for us to see you. Call us by name, again and again, as many
times as it takes for us to hear you. Pull us from the trenches of our grief and give
us reason to hope. **Amen.**
